What are Renewable Resources?

**A resource that can
be replaced by
nature over time**

Examples:

- Trees
- Rain
- Sunlight



What are Nonrenewable Resources?



- **Something that cannot be replaced by nature fast enough by the rate it is being used.**
- **Examples:**
 - **Metal (iron/steel)**
 - **Gold**
 - **Coal**
